

Hooky Recycling FAQ's



- What can be recycled through the Hooky Recycling Scheme?

 - Our current list of recyclable items includes:
 - Crisp Packets
 - Pill Blister Packs
 - Toothbrushes and Flossing Sticks
 - Sweet Wrappers
 - Bread Packets
 - Cheese Packaging
 - Warburton's Wax Wraps
 - Biscuit, Cracker and Cake Wrappers
- Where are the Recycling Bins
 - At the edge of the Library / Norman Matthews Hall carpark
 - At the edge of the area where the bottle banks used to be at the Primary School – on the left as you drive into the car park.
 - There are also bins inside school for break-time and lunch-time wrappers as well as bins for bakery packaging from the breakfast club.
- How do I know what I can put in the bins?
 - The bins are all clearly labelled to indicate what can be put in them.
- What happens to the contents of the bins?
 - The bins are emptied on a regular basis and the contents are stored until there is enough to send off to [Terracycle](#) for processing, or to other recycling outlets.
 - Pill packets are currently being taken to Boots in Chipping Norton for recycling.
